EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

For SCAN's first quarter of 2019, I will be working with Service Provider Chair Yvette Estrada in initiating negotiations with our six service providers on renewing their contracts with SCAN.

Most of the service providers are working under contracts that were negotiated in 2016. Though the engagement criteria remains essentially the same, there are expanded requirements that need to be acknowledged contractually, especially in relation to the updated SCAN audit and U.S. Customs' updated minimum security criteria of the CTPAT program.

We hope to circulate the new contract to service providers by the end of April, concluding with negotiations by the end of May.

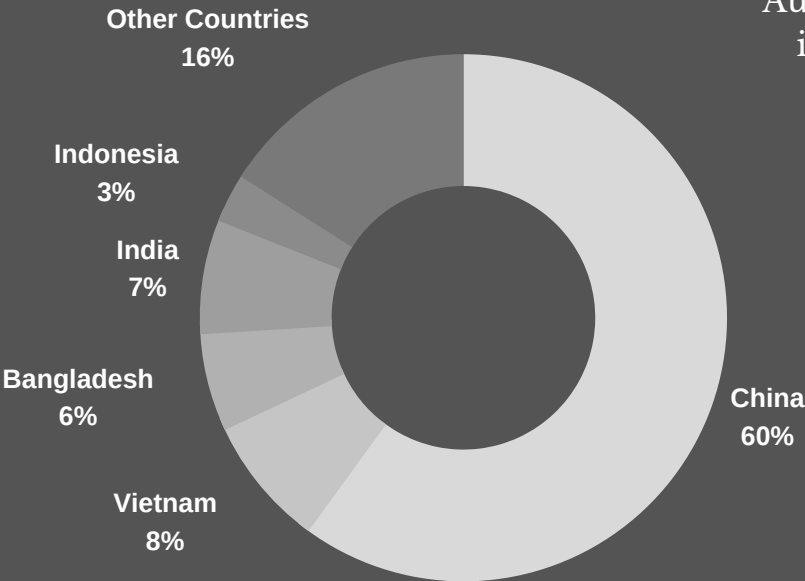
